

## Greetings

You both are about to commence the opportunity to complete the Online Customised Version of Prepare-Enrich. The cost will be approx. \$50 per couple and will fluctuate due to exchange differences.

This will either be paid by yourselves by credit card as part of the login process or charged to you by your facilitator.

It will be helpful to you and will contribute to the integrity of the reports and enhance the feedback process if you observe these guidelines and criteria.

You will both be asked in an email to log on to the Data entry page via the email received from myself, your Facilitator. You will both use the unique couple number assigned by the system.

The first person to log on will be asked to complete several customizing questions as to your present relationship status, children either present or intended, age, cultural differences etc.

Following these questions a unique set of questions will be developed by the programme and available to both of you to complete. You are then able to separately answer your own questions from your Internet access.

You can pause the answer process and the programme will save your responses and allow you to come back to the next question to be answered.

Once a page of questions is completed you cannot go back to amend your answers.

We suggest that you avoid as much as possible the use of 3 for indecision.

Also you will find there are different types of questions i.e. I..., we... and my partner... questions.

We suggest that before you answer that you ask yourself the question and then answer accordingly.

We also urge you not to share your responses with your partner as you answer, as this will reduce the integrity of the resulting reports.

When the last question is answered the system will develop and store the reports and email a link to myself your Facilitator to advise that the reports are ready to download.

You will then be contacted for the resulting feedback and skill building sessions.
